Those who wish to present data at the annual meeting are invited to submit an abstract, NO LATER THAN **5st of March 2023**. Electronic submission of abstracts fulfilling all requirements (see below) can be made by e-mail to <u>bsac@uzbrussel.be</u>.

Abstracts will be evaluated for acceptance by the BSAC board members. The best abstracts will be selected for short presentation during the storm session (5-10 minutes, depending on the number of abstracts). By **10th of March 2023** the presenting author will be notified whether the abstract has been accepted, and if so, of the proposed type of presentation (oral or poster).

All accepted abstracts will be composed into one PDF and send out to all participants. To encourage young scientists to publish their data, we'll grant the best abstracts with a **poster award**.

The presenting author of the abstract must register for the meeting. Deadline for registration is **15th of March 2023**.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

- The content of the abstract must be related to flow cytometry, research or diagnostics.
- The acceptable length of the abstract is a maximum of 500 words.
 - The abstract should be structured into the following sections:
 - o A title which clearly indicates the nature of the investigation
 - o Objectives
 - o Methods
 - o Results
 - o Conclusion
 - o 1 figure or table may be included in the abstract itself

Case reports are also accepted. In this case, the format may deviate from the above.


